This book is probably the best introduction to Brueggemann, one of today's leading OT scholars. This is a brief volume suitable for individuals and groups, with discussion questions at the end of each chapter.

Brueggemann wants us to learn to read the Bible as an "insider," to see life from a biblical perspective. Think of this book as a road map into the strange world of the Bible. He helps us to use our imaginations and to see the Bible as more than a newspaper-like account of the past. Scripture is God's Word and the spiritual journal of God's people.
